If you are planning on volunteering in our school this year, please complete the following form. Only one form is needed per person, you do not need to complete a form for each child on the **Volunteer Form**

First Day of School:

We are excited to welcome students on the First Day of School. Please review the **Student Entrance Map**. The cement will be marked appropriately where students will line up outside in their classes. Families and students are expected to wait at the assigned spots on the map until asked to proceed into the school by school staff.

Our school doors will open at 8:25 a.m. At this time, you may enter the building. Once entering the designated entrance, please have your child place their outdoor shoes on their classroom boot rack and proceed to their classroom. If you have any questions while waiting outside, please find a member of our staff wearing a supervision vest to assist you. We will be using 4 entrances for students. The main (front) entrance is reserved for staff and visitors. We will have staff outside to assist in case of any confusion. Teachers will be in their classrooms waiting to meet you.

Please ensure you have logged into Powerschool so you are aware of your child's teacher. Room locations are listed beside the teacher's name above.

While on school grounds, please ensure photos taken are of your child(ren) only. As well, while on school property, there are no pets allowed.

Student Drop Off and Visitor Parking

Please use the Drop and Go loop for student drop off. Upon entering the loop, proceed as far down the loop as possible to make room for other vehicles before pausing to let your children out. If you plan to exit your vehicle for any length of time, please park in Visitor parking at the North end of the loop. Drop off and parking is also available on Heritage Drive. Please do not park in the staff parking lot as staff, consultants and other EIPS employees come and go throughout the day. As well, please do not park in the handicapped parking spots unless you have a valid parking sticker to do so; we do have families that require the use of these spots.

Meet The Staff Evening:

On Wednesday, September 6th from 6:00-7:30 p.m, Heritage Hills Elementary, our School Council and our fundraising association (FAHHE) will host our meet the staff evening together. The evening will start at 6:00 pm where we invite all families to meet in the gym for a brief presentation. Once the presentation is over, families can tour the school and classrooms and grab a hotdog.
